

**CURRICULUM OF LECTURES IN CLINICAL PROSTHETIC DENTAL MEDICINE  
4 YEAR, 8 SEMESTER (SUMMER),**

**15 weeks, 2 academic hours every second week**

<b>Week</b>	<b>Lecture subjects</b>
<b>1</b>	<b>I.</b> Specific treatment methods for complete edentulism in cases of prognathia, progenia, normal or prominent maxillary tuberosities, gagging reflex, microstoma, allergy. <b>II.</b> Immediate prosthetic treatment with complete dentures.
<b>3</b>	<b>III.</b> Prosthetic treatment in childhood. Developmental stages. Indications and contraindications. Prosthetic restoration requirements. <b>IV.</b> Clinical aspects of prosthetic treatment of partially or completely destructed crowns of primary teeth, partial or complete edentulism of primary dentition. Clinical and laboratory characteristics of prosthetic treatment in childhood.
<b>5</b>	<b>V.</b> Patient adaptation to the dentures. Stages of adaptation. Change of the circumstantial and initiation of the unconditional research reflex. <b>VI.</b> Dental prosthetic treatment complications – of teeth, periodontium, dental arches, mucosa, interocclusal relations, TMJ, masticatory muscles, including in childhood.
<b>7</b>	<b>VII.</b> Prosthetic treatment of TMJ and masticatory muscles: Costen syndrome, trauma of the articular disc, habitual luxation, mechanotherapy of masticatory muscles, boxing splint.
<b>9</b>	<b>VIII.</b> Patient examination and treatment planning in Dental Implantology – study models, surgical guides, radiological methods.
<b>11</b>	<b>IX.</b> Implant treatment of partially edentulous patients – single-tooth implant restorations and fixed bridge restorations. Impression technique in Dental Implantology.
<b>13</b>	<b>X.</b> Maxillo-facial prosthetics. Types of injuries in maxillo-facial region. Classification of maxillo-facial prostheses.
<b>15</b>	<b>XI.</b> Maxillo-facial prosthetics. Types of postresection prostheses. Obturators and epitheses.

1	<b>I.</b> Prosthetic treatment of partially edentulous patients with one-piece cast framework partial dentures. Prosthetic preparation - 16 hours.

5	<b>II.</b> Seminar: Comprehensive treatment of periodontal disease – 2 hours. <b>III.</b> Prosthetic periodontal therapy within comprehensive treatment. Selective grinding, splinting of periodontally compromised teeth with fixed and removable permanent splints – 20 hours. <b>IV.</b> Seminar: Sequence of preventive and therapeutic procedures in the process of complete patient rehabilitation – 2 hours.
