<b>B</b>	<b>OPTIONAL COURSES</b>																

- 1 Each student is required to complete two of the elective courses during the entire course of education.
- 2 Students can voluntarily complete other elective and /or optional courses approved in the curriculum of the specialty.
- 3 ECTS credits reflect the knowledge and skills acquired in the curriculum, based on the results shown through various forms of training (colloquia, tests, exams)
- 4 ECTS credits are calculated in accordance with the requirements of Ordinance №21 / 30.09.2004 of the Ministry of Education and Science on the application of a system for accumulation and transfer of credits in high schools - 1credit=30 hours , compulsory classes < self-study
- 5 Students receive credits for all semesters in the course of study in a given discipline until the exam.
